A. Dress Code Policy

Dress Code Rules will be strictly enforced. Bexar County Academy has a uniform policy. All students and parents should take this into consideration before enrolling at Bexar County Academy.

1. Students must be in uniform each school day.
2. New students who enroll will be given one week to get their uniforms. During that grace week the students must be dressed neatly and modestly. No hats, jerseys, jeans or tank tops or open toed shoes will be permitted.
3. Visible facial piercings are not allowed. (Tongue, nose, lip, chin, eyebrow)
Gang related apparel will not be permitted. No heavy chains worn or carried are allowed on campus. Pockets should not have any hanging items exposed, such as bandanas.

4. Predominately unnatural hair coloring will not be permitted, such as pink, purple, green, and blue. Hair for both boys and girls should be styled so that eye(s) are not covered. Hair must be neat, clean, out of the eyes and must not distract or disrupt the learning processes.
5. Students must wear their complete uniform throughout the day and for all official functions, which include school outings and field trips unless administration gives other instructions.
6. Hoods, or other head coverings or blankets are not allowed in school.
7. **No Hoodies allowed**- must zip in the front and be navy blue or have the school logo.
8. Sweaters may be worn in class if student is cold.

B. Dress Code

Uniforms

Pre-K-2nd Grades

Navy Blue polo shirt (long or short sleeve), or school logo shirt

Khaki, Navy, or Black Pants/Shorts/Skirt/ Navy or Khaki jumpers

Tennis Shoes or closed toed shoes (any color) suitable for physical activity.

Grades3-8

Navy Blue polo shirt (long or short sleeve), or school logo shirt

Khaki, Navy, Black Pants/Shorts/Skirt/ Navy or Khaki jumpers

All pants must fit properly and not be baggy or sag or be worn below waistline.

Tennis Shoes (any color) or closed toed shoes suitable for physical activity.

Students may wear shirts outside of pants provided the shirt has a straight hem, fits properly, and does not hang down below pocket level. Shirts hanging to the knees are not acceptable. Any Bexar County Academy purchased t-shirt is allowed during school.

No undergarments should be visible at any time.

Casual days will be announced. Students should not assume that every Friday is a casual day. On casual day, students may wear clothing of their own choosing as long as their dress is not bizarre, disorderly in appearance, or gang related. **Modesty** is the key word.

Jeans should be without **holes or frayed areas**. Shoes should be **close toed**. No tank tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops or tight-fitting tops are allowed. Dresses need to be no shorter than two inches above the knee. Shorts may be no more than four inches above the knee when standing up.

Note: If a student is out of dress code, they will not be allowed to go to class. The student will stay in the Behavior Management classroom until a parent/guardian can bring them an appropriate school uniform.
